
2net Alice Web Browser ...grows or shrinks to fit the application

Alice was developed to run in environments where main-stream browsers just won't fit: in situations where there isn't much memory, where the processor isn't very powerful or where there isn't a large display. For example, hand-held computers, machine information displays and public display systems. Rather like the character in "Alice in Wonderland", the Alice browser will grow or shrink to fit your system's needs Alice is the ONLY sub-megabyte browser for DOS operating systems, but that is not all. Alice can also run without DOS

- Modular: display driver and input device drivers are separately loaded

- Dialer and PPP supplied for dial-up connection




System Requirements (DOS version)

- Intel x86 compatible CPU
- 450 Kbytes free RAM
- MS-DOS 3.3 or compatible
- A network adapter and packet driver or Hayes compatible modem

Architecture



The browser is based on the Grow Graphical User Interface which has been developed over a number of years by Grow Software. It uses object oriented techniques to make it easy to change the "personality" to suit the target environment, for example to look like Windows or Mac.

Grow uses dynamically loaded driver files for the device-dependent parts of the system such as the display and input devices. A standard set of drivers are supplied
